## Yale University Department of Anesthesiology Research Scholars Program (RSP) Application

The Scholarships are typically available to 1-2 residents per year. It is anticipated that Research Scholars will work to develop their research program during residency, often taking up to 6 months in the CA-3 year for full-time research.

Although RSP residents sometimes continue into our Departmental NIH-supported T32 postdoctoral fellowship, the two programs are distinct, and admission to one does not imply admission to the other. At the completion of residency, some Research Scholars enter the T32 program and spend 2 years in their mentor's basic science laboratory or clinical research group. For those who do the RSP and the T32 program, it is our hope that these scholars will be optimally positioned to embark on independent science careers - often as members of our faculty. All RSP residents from CA-1 through CA-3 year will receive a supplement of \$12,000 per annum as an award during residency.
