COVID SCREENING QUESTIONS UPDATED 12/2/2020

In the last 2 weeks, have you tested positive for COVID-19 or knowingly been exposed to anyone with COVID-19?

<u>OR</u>

Do you have any of the following symptoms?

- Fever> 100F or chills
 - New cough
- New shortness of breath/difficulty breathing
 - New sore throat
 - New loss of taste or smell
 - New chills or muscle pain
 - New congestion or runny nose
 - New vomiting or diarrhea

Patients with <u>known</u> COVID-19 infection:

Safe to image at any site if <u>ALL the following are met</u>: 10 days after the onset of symptoms or day of positive test (if patient asymptomatic) (20 days for severe cases or for immunocompromised)


AND

24 hours fever free (<u>Without</u> fever reducing medications)

AND

Other symptoms are improving

Determining COVID precautions for COVID-19 positive outpatients, including those with immunocompromise, history of cancer or recovery from severe COVID infection
