

## **Pathology and Molecular Medicine Travel Fellowship**

**Amount:** \$1,000 biannually

**Application deadlines:** July 1 and January 1.

The Department of Pathology will provide a travel grant for two Pathology and Molecular Medicine students to support travel to recognized professional domestic or international conferences and academic meetings.

### **Requirements:**

Pathology and Molecular Medicine Graduate Student in good standing.

A student may only have one application pending at any time.

Must be presenting an abstract

**Selection Process:** Travel Award Committee consists of faculty and Graduate Students. The committee will review all the applications and notify the applicants of the decisions.

### **Application requirements:**

- 1) Name, Lab, Year of Study
- 2) Conference details –Official title, dates, and place. Include brochure.
- 3) Abstract must be provided
- 4) Statement of how this conference will benefit your research
- 5) Budget breakdown (registration fee, transportation, and meals and lodging)

***ALL application requirements must be included for consideration.***

### **Submit all documentation in one PDF.**

The awardee must submit a short statement of what you presented and learned from the conference.

The awardee should work with their PI's administrative assistant to book travel and reservations adhering to University Policy. Once the conference concludes, they should forward receipts to their PI's administrative assistant. Graduate Registrar will provide the COA to the administrative assistant.
