Internal Medicine HIV Training Track	Three-year track within the Yale Primary Care Internal Medicine Residency Program focused on HIV medicine ( <a href="http://hivtraining.yale.edu">http://hivtraining.yale.edu</a> )	10
Elective in HIV Care/Urban Health	Two-week elective based in a multidisciplinary HIV outpatient clinic	10
Home Visit Elective	Two-week elective focused on developing skills and comfort with conducting primary care home visits	10
Street Medicine Elective	Two-week elective focused on developing skills and comfort with providing care to homeless populations	10
Community Care Van	Outreach/direct care program for early intervention and linkage to care for individuals in low-income neighborhoods	2 per session
Refugee Clinic	Resident-run clinic that provides care to newly arrived refugees and links them to community providers	2 per session
Center for Asylum Medicine Evaluation	Participation in forensic medical evaluation of asylum applicants	2 per session
HAVEN Free Clinic	Student-run multidisciplinary primary care clinic for uninsured patients	2 per session

Global Health Foundations Seminar	Weekly introductory seminar addressing key issues in global health research and practice	2 per session
Topics in Global Medicine	Weekly student-led, case-based seminar focusing on key clinical issues in global health.	2 per session
Critical Issues in Global Health	Weekly seminar focusing on the health of vulnerable communities in LMICs, including the politics and governance of global health, and low-cost solutions.	2 per session
Global Mental Health Program Seminar	Series of lectures focused on key issues in global mental health	2 per session
Global Health Night Out	Quarterly journal club/discussion sessions bringing together trainee and faculty discussants from different clinical disciplines/health professions around one topic	2 per session

Conference Presentation <b>OR</b> Manuscript Submission	May take advantage of local, national, or international opportunities for presenting scholarly work (poster or oral), as well as peer-reviewed publication opportunities in journals or MedEdPORTAL	Required
Dissemination Back to Target Community	Demonstrate an implementable plan for sharing scholarship results with the subjects of that work	Required
Communicating About Global Health	Global Health Night Out (Discussion Lead) OR Op-Ed submitted for publication OR Noon Conference (Global Health-focused) OR Global Health Week activity (leadership role)	Required
Immersive Clinical Activity Presentation	Lecture presentation related to immersive clinical activity – focus on linking clinical case to global burden of disease	Required
