CLINICAL SERVICES

Multidisciplinary Evaluation:

- Team of experts spanning psychology, psychiatry, and speech and language
- Assessment focuses on diagnosis, determination of strengths and weaknesses related to learning style, cognitive profile, communication, social behavior, and daily living skills
- Report provides recommendations for intervention and educational planning

Educational Advocacy:

- Assists parents in obtaining appropriate supports in schools

College Planning:

- Helps parents and students with autism select appropriate college settings and supports families through the application and admission process

Social Skills Groups:

- Groups for children ages 7-17 who are diagnosed with autism
