It is mandatory that all PPTP trainees participate in the following PPTP-related activities:

Systems Pharmacology and Integrated Therapeutics (SPIT) Workshop for entering 2nd year students:

The goal of this workshop is to provide an in-depth “hands-on” experience in drug design, drug discovery, high throughput screening, state-of-the-art proteomics, genomics, and target validation. This will be a mandatory workshop for all PPTP trainees.

PPTP-supported departmental seminars:

All students are required to attend the PPTP-supported departmental seminars, which consists of a series of primary research lectures given by prominent scientists in Pharmacology and related fields. We also organize a lunch for the students with the seminar speaker.

Research-in-progress talks:

When students begin their 3rd year, they are required to present their on-going work annually to the entire department (students, postdocs, and faculty) in a 25-minute Research-in-Progress (RIP) seminar where they will have the opportunity to orally communicate their work and to receive feedback from others.

Annual Departmental/PPTP retreat:

The department also hosts a Fall retreat where faculty, students, and post-doctoral fellows present and discuss research through oral and poster sessions.

Attend Responsible Conduct of Research:

A mandatory Responsible Conduct of Research (RCR) refresher course will be offered in the 4th year.
