**Internship Program Admissions**

The Yale Doctoral Internship in Clinical and Community Psychology offers internship positions based at either the Connecticut Mental Health Center or Yale-New Haven Hospital. Applicants apply for one, and only one placement, within the program. The internship, which embraces a scientist-practitioner model, is most appropriate for and gives a strong preference to students from graduate programs that have a scientist-practitioner or clinical-scientist training model. Additional admission criteria are described below. *Does the program require that applicants have received a minimum number of hours of the following at time of application? 3. Has passed the comprehensive or qualifying exam by the time of application (unless such an exam is not required by the graduating program); and
4. Has an approved dissertation proposal by the time of application.

Exceptions are not made to these criteria. Applications from candidates who do not meet all criteria will not be processed.
