# DRS. ALONZO AND STROUMBAKIS JOIN YALE UROLOGY IN GREENWICH





We are happy to announce the appointment of **Dr. Catherine Alonzo** and **Dr. Nicholas Stroumbakis** as Assistant Professors of Clinical Urology.

Dr. Alonzo specializes in the care of women with voiding dysfunctions, incontinence, and kidney stones, as well as urologic cancers. She joins Yale Urology as Assistant Professor of Clinical Urology and will continue to see patients in Greenwich. Dr. Alonzo received her Master of Science degree from Georgetown University and her Medical Degree from Drexel University College of Medicine. She completed her internship at UConn School of Medicine, and residency training at Nassau University Medical Center in General Surgery and New York Medical College in Urology.

Dr. Stroumbakis offers his patients laparoscopic, robotic, and other minimally invasive techniques for treating urologic cancers. A large focus of his practice is also on men's health, including a special interest in the diagnosis and treatment of BPH and erectile dysfunction. Previously the Director of Surgical Oncology at Greenwich Hospital, Dr. Stroumbakis received his Medical Degree from Icahn School of Medicine at Mount Sinai, and he completed his surgical internship and residency training at New York Medical College. Dr. Stroumbakis trained in Urology Oncology at Memorial Sloan Kettering Cancer Center before joining Greenwich Urological Associates in 1996.

Drs. Alonzo and Stroumbakis will continue to see patients at their clinic located at 49 Lake Avenue in Greenwich, which is directly adjacent to Greenwich Hospital.



Patrick Kenney, MD is leading a Phase III Clinical Trial studying Tokyo-172 strain bacillus Calmette-Guerin (BCG) solution with or without a vaccination using Tokyo-172 strain BCG to see how well it works compared with TICE BCG solution in treating patients with non-muscle invasive bladder cancer.

BCG is a non-infectious bacteria that when instilled into the bladder may stimulate the immune system to fight bladder cancer. Giving different versions of BCG with vaccine therapy may prevent bladder cancer from returning.
